COSTS & WARRANTIES

What are the costs?

There are two components to the fees for fitting miniscleral contact lenses, the consultation fee for fitting the lenses and the fee for the actual lenses.

The consultation fee for fitting miniscleral lenses is **\$499.20** which covers all visits associated with fitting, adjusting and monitoring the lenses other than your initial visit. Medicare provides a rebate of \$195.80 for this item, which will leave you with an out-of-pocket cost of around \$300 on this fee.

The miniscleral lenses cost **\$645 to \$715** each, depending on the manufacturer and the complexity of the lens design. This fee covers the initial lens and up to two further lenses if changes need to be made. If you have private health insurance with extras/ancillary cover you will be able to claim a rebate on the lenses.

Warranties – what happens if lenses are not successful?

If fitting has not been successful even after a third lens, a refund of \$235 per lens will be provided. No refund is provided on the consultation fees.
